**DAY 1**...Off you go to NYC with an early morning departure from Fort Wayne and Decatur. Travel to New York City area where you will check into your hotel. Meals will be on your own along the way.

**DAY 2**... Following breakfast at hotel, board motorcoach and travel into Manhattan. First on our agenda is a tour of the world-famous **Madison Square Garden**. Afterwards we will stop at **Rockefeller Center** to enjoy lunch on own and free time. Take time to shop on Fifth Avenue, visit NBC Studios and St. Patrick's Cathedral. Later we will meet our guide for a **Tour of Upper Manhattan** including a walk in Central Park. We will see the Lincoln Center, United Nations, Harlem and St. John Divine Cathedral. Dinner is included before ending our day with a spectacular **Broadway Play**. Back to hotel for some zzzzz's. (B, D)

**DAY 3**...Enjoy breakfast, then depart for Battery Park in lower Manhattan to board Statue Cruises Ferry. Cruise to Liberty Island where you will visit the **Statue of Liberty**. Your enhanced visit will include an audio tour which will guide you through the unique history of Liberty Island from its time as a fort through the construction of the Statue of Liberty and its establishment as a national monument. After your visit, board the ferry and cruise to **Ellis Island**, a landmark which symbolizes America's immigrant heritage. The Museum is designed as a self-guided museum with three floors of audio/visual displays and exhibits detailing the history of the immigration process from 1912 to 1954. Your enhanced visit will include an audio tour through all three levels of the historic Main Building while allowing you to vividly relive the immigrant experience through first hand immigration accounts. You will also have the opportunity to see the Wall of Honor which lists the names of the immigrants that arrived on Ellis Island. Board the ferry and return to Battery Park. Next stop.....**Grand Central Terminal**. Be transported by the iconic beauty and lasting legacy of Grand Central Terminal. This historic world-famous landmark in Midtown Manhattan opened to the public in February 1913, Grand Central Terminal is a story of great engineering, survival, and rebirth. Dinner is included this evening in Manhattan. The day will end with a visit to the **Empire State Building** from where you will have a spectacular view of New York City's five boroughs and New Jersey. Back to hotel....sweet dreams! (B, D)

DAY 4...After breakfast, we will once again return to Manhattan to meet our local guide for a **Tour of Lower Manhattan**. The tour includes the famous buildings and colorful districts such as Soho, Little Italy, Chinatown, the Garment District, The Financial District, and Ground Zero. Following lunch on own, proceed to the **9/11 Memorial for a Guided Tour of the National 9/11 Memorial Museum** which is dedicated to those who lost their lives on September 11, 2001. This evening's dinner is included. After dinner, you will have free time to explore **Times Square**. Time to say "good by" to the Big Apple. (B D)
