NOVA SCOTIA, PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND & CAPE BRETON ISLAND

Featuring Hopewell Rocks, The Cabot Trail & Acadia National Park

July 29 – August 10, 2022

Day 1 - Depart from Indiana and travel to Rochester, NY for overnight lodging; dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 2 - After breakfast, check out and continue traveling to Southern Maine with rest/lunch stops on your own along the way. After check-in at your hotel in the Portland area, enjoy a delicious dinner, which is followed by a relaxing evening. B, D

Day 3 - Breakfast, then check out and travel to Moncton, New Brunswick ... crossing into Canada at Calais, ME. After check-in at your hotel enjoy a delicious dinner. B, D

Day 4 - Following breakfast, check out and begin your journey to **Prince Edward Island** along the **Bay of Fundy** coast to **Hopewell Rocks** where 50-foot tides have carved the world's largest "flowerpots" out of the cliffs. Nowhere else on earth are the tides as high as in the Bay of Fundy. In the afternoon, you will cross the Northumberland Strait on the 8-mile Confederation Bridge which connects New Brunswick with Prince Edward Island. Check into your hotel for the next two nights and enjoy a delicious dinner. B, D

Day 5 - After breakfast this morning, you will enjoy a **city tour of Charlottetown**, the largest town in the province. In the afternoon arrive in the scenic village of New Glasgow to visit the **Prince Edward Island Preserve Company** for a chance to sample some of the wonderful products. Afterwards, continue to the **National Historic Site of Anne of Green Gables**. This famous novel was written by island native Lucy Maud Montgomery and has become the symbol of Prince Edward Island. The home that inspired the Green Gables setting has been carefully maintained in the 1800's style and is staffed with knowledgeable guides. A delicious lobster dinner will complete your day before returning to your hotel for the night. B, D

Day 6 - Following breakfast, check out and travel back across the Confederation Bridge into Nova Scotia. Continue along the Northumberland coastline to **Cape Breton Island**, which is connected to the mainland of Nova Scotia by a causeway. Arrive in Baddeck to visit the world-famous **Alexander Graham Bell Museum** which overlooks the Bras d'Or Lake. This complex features three exhibit halls with the largest collection of Bell's artifacts and inventions, including a replica of the first telephone and full scale model of the HD-4 hydrofoil craft. Afterwards, check into your hotel for two nights; dinner has been arranged for you this evening. B, D

Day 7 - Enjoy breakfast, then depart on one of nature's magnificent regions ... the stunning **Cabot Trail**, named for the famous explorer John Cabot. The Trail winds around the rocky splendor of Cape Breton's northern shore, ascending the incredible plateaus of **Cape Breton Highlands National Park**, rising high above the shimmering waters of the Gulf of Saint Lawrence. Enjoy the vistas of the rugged coastline where pods of whales can often be seen just offshore and bald eagles soar aloft on the ocean breezes. A delicious dinner will end your day. B, D

Day 8 - After breakfast, check out and travel to Halifax, Nova Scotia for two nights of lodging in this capital city. Enjoy a short **city tour of Halifax** upon arrival before checking into your hotel. Dinner has been arranged for you this evening. B, D

Day 9 - Following breakfast, begin a day of touring with a visit to **Peggy's Cove** to see this picturesque fishing village. Later, return to Halifax to visit the **Maritime Museum of the Atlantic**, located along the boardwalk of the Halifax Harbor in the Historic District. Learn more about the maritime history of the region including the Great Explosion and the Titanic's sinking. Later, visit the Fairview Cemetery where the victims of the Titanic disaster who washed ashore in Nova Scotia were buried. Your tour will end with a visit to the stunning **Halifax Public Gardens**. Once again, dinner will end your day. B, D

Day 10 - Following breakfast, check out and travel along the **Evangeline Trail** to the delightful town of **Annapolis Royal** before boarding the **Digby Ferry** across the Bay of Fundy to St. John, New Brunswick where lodging has been arranged for you this evening. Dinner will be on the board the ferry this evening. B, D

Day 11 - After breakfast, check out and visit the famous **Reversing Falls** ... a natural phenomenon where the high tides of the Bay of Fundy meet and overpower the St. John River and force it to reverse and flow back upstream. Travel back to Maine with a stop at **Campobello** to visit Franklin D. Roosevelt's summer home and retreat. Campobello Island, one of the three Fundy Isles, is located in the Bay of Fundy. This Canadian Island lies just off shore of the most eastern town in the United States, Lubec, ME. Upon arrival in the U.S., adjust your watches back one hour. Continue to **Bar Harbor for a tour**, including **Acadia National Park**, one of the most spectacular parks in the U.S. with views across two states from its highest peak on Cadillac Mountain. Continue traveling to Bangor, ME for dinner and overnight lodging. check into your hotel and freshen up for a delicious dinner. B, D

Day 12 - Enjoy breakfast and travel to Rochester, NY for overnight lodging, dinner is on your own this evening. B

Day 13 - Following breakfast, check-out and prepare for your departure home with fond memories of Maritime Canada. B
