If you've not seen a solar eclipse, put it on your bucket list and mark the date! It is truly a breath-taking sight and you will never regret traveling to see the Sun's corona. The 2024 eclipse will also last longer and cast a wider shadow than the 2017 eclipse, meaning it'll be more easily viewed by more people. (It won't happen again until 2045.)

Eclipse Day, April 8, 2024, Prestonsburg, KY. The eclipse starts at 12:44 with the magnitude of the eclipse at 2:03 and it ends at 3:19 PM. Per the Kentucky Science Center which is considered ONE of the most technologically advance planetariums in the world. Prestonsburg will have approximately 97.9% totality for the the 2024 Eclipse. DAY 1...OFF WE GO! Sit back and relax. Rest breaks and Lunch stop on the way. Check in at our hotel for three nights. Dinner is included with entertainment tonight. Sweet dreams! (D)

DAY 2....After breakfast, depart with guide for Elk Viewing. Kentucky is now considered the “Elk Capital East of the Rockies”. Thanks to an absence of predators and an abundance of food, the elk population has grown to an estimate size of 10,000. The best area for elk habitat are on reclaimed surface mines in Eastern Kentucky. Next stop is the US 23 Country Music Highway Museum. The Museum is dedicated to the entertainers who were born or lived near US Route 23 in eastern Kentucky. Entertainers exhibited within the museum include Billy Ray Cyrus, The Judds, Ricky Skaggs, Loretta Lynn, Keith Whitley, Dwight Yoakum, Patty Loveless and Gary Stewart. Mountain Home Place is the next stop. The setting is a glance back in time to the mid-1800’s to a typical rural farm in the mountains of Eastern Kentucky. Lunch is included at the Home Place with entertainment. Back to hotel for some time to relax. Dinner is included tonight at the Mountain Arts Center (MAC). Following dinner enjoy a fabulous show at the MAC. Billie Jean Osborne’s Kentucky Opry will keep your feet tapping and hands clapping. For over 30 years, audiences have enjoyed a musical variety show featuring familiar bluegrass, country, and gospel songs, and homespun mountain-style comedy from a rotating cast of rising stars, all of whom hail from the mountains of Eastern Kentucky. Back to hotel. (B, L, D)

DAY 3....ECLIPSE DAY!!! After breakfast....the fun begins. We will head toward the amphitheater at the convention center for the entire day. Live musical entertainment, the re-telling of the Jenny Wiley Story, local artisan vendors, food trucks for lunch and throughout the day, homemade Moonpies, engaging lectures by expert astronomer, drum circle lessons and outdoor games. More info about activities closer to departure date. The eclipse starts at 12:44 with the magnitude of the eclipse at 2:03 and it ends at 3:19. During the eclipse portion, chairs will be available to sit outside to view. There will be a DJ for the eclipse portion, playing all songs that have to do with the sun and moon PLUS, of course, “Total Eclipse of the Heart”. Back to hotel to relax before dinner. Off we go to Moonshine Hide-Away Tour, Dinner, Entertainment and Moonshine Tasting. Group receives a demonstration of the process of how the old timers brewed that famous mountain “white lightin’”. The Shiners will take up their instruments and sing a couple of moonshine songs. A BBQ dinner is included followed by a performance of the Moon Shine Band at the Convention Center. What a Day!!! (B, D)

DAY 4....Following breakfast and checking out of hotel, we will visit the East Kentucky Science Center and Planetarium located on the Campus of the Big Sandy Community and Technical College....considered one of the most technologically advanced planetariums in the world. Next stop is the Mayo Methodist Church built by local coal baron, John C.C. Mayo and donated to the congregation in 1909. Church is on the National Historic Register and houses a Pichner organ given to Mayo by Andrew Carnegie. Note: Let us know if you would like to play the organ. Lunch is included before heading home. (B, L)
