Day One...All Aboard!!!! The first stop in Kentucy is at the <u>Ward Hall Mansion</u>. Indulge in a unique bourbon tasting experience amidst the historical charm of Ward Hall in Kentucky. Immerse yourself in the ambiance of this equisite antebellum mansion as you savor the finest bourbons that the region has to offer. With its elegant surroundings and rich heritage, Ward Hall provides the perfect backdrop for an intimate and memoralbe bourbon tasting session. Whether you are a seasoned bourbon enthusiast or a newcomer to the world of spirits, this experience allows you to appreciate the nuances of each slip while surrounded by the timeless beauty of a bygone era. Raise your glass to a sophisticated journey through Kentucky's history and the flavors that define it legacy. Next stop is at <u>Equus Run Vineyard</u> for a wine tasting. The vineyards are an inspired vision to work the rich fertile soil of the Kentucky Bluegrass in a county steeped with equine tradition, a tobacco and cattle farm gave way to what is now Equus Run Vineyards. The vision became reality in january 1998 with the combine efforts of friends and family. Dinner included this evening at <u>Wilshire's Restaurant</u> located in the historic home of General John Payne. Erected in approximately 1790, this 11-room colonial residence is an ecellent example of Kentucky's "Stone Age". Time to call it a day and check-in at hotel. (D)

Day Two...Following included breakfast at hotel, we will depart for a busy day. Our day starts with a walking tour of <u>Keeneland</u>. A National Historic Landmark, Keeneland features beautifully landscaped grounds and home to spectacular Thoroughbred racing and the world's largest Thoroughbred auction company. Next stop is the <u>Castle and Key Distillery</u>. Guests will take a journey through time to discover how the Key to the Castle was found after decades of disarray and abandonment. You will view 20th century distillation equipment with modern updates along with the blooming florals of the sunken garden. Finish your visit with a tasty twist on unique ways to enjoy your favorite Spirits. Boxed lunch included after the tour. A stop will be made at <u>Woodford Reserve</u>. Now a National Historic Landmark, the art of making fine bourbon first took place here in 1812. The history of bourbon is the history of Kentucky, is the history of the United States. Our day continues with a visit to <u>Mill Ridge Horse Farm</u>, founded by Alice Chandler in 1962. The Farm has a rich history of raising selling Thoroughbred racehorses. Today, her legacy shines through in all aspects of the farm, which is led by her son and grandson. Since 2000, Mill Ridge Farm has bred, raised, and/or sold 37 Grade 1 Winners. Dinner is included this evening. Hotel check-in. (B, L, D)

Day Three... After checking out of hotel, we will enjoy **Backstretch Breakfast at Churchill Downs**. There's no experience quite like a once-in-a-lifetime chance to spend a morning on the backside at Churchill Downs Racetrack where you can get a behind the scenes view of Thoroughbred racing at the "World's Most Legendary Racetrack". Along with more than 1,400 stalls, enjoy breakfast in the Horsemen's Track Kitchen, see the horses training rail side, catch them during a bath and learn about life at the track. Following breakfast and tour, you will spend time with a self-guided visit in the **Kentucky Derby Museum**. Lunch is own your own. After lunch, tour and tasting is included at **Frazier History Museum**. The Frazier History Museum is where the world meets Kentucky. Located on Museum Row in the Bourbon District of downtown Louisville, the Frazier documents and reinterprets stories from history using artifacts, gallery talks, and live daily interpretations by a talented staff of costumed actors known as teaching artists.
